Gert Brunekreeft is professor of energy economics at Jacobs University Bremen in Germany and head of the research group Bremen Energy Research. He holds a degree in economics from the University of Groningen (Netherlands, 1992) and a PhD in economics from Freiburg University (Germany, 1996).

His main research interests are in industrial economics, regulation theory and competition policy of network industries, especially electricity and gas markets. Current issues concern market design, economics of smart grids and infrastructure investment. He is the author of several books and published in academic journals, including *Journal of Regulatory Economics*, *Utilities Policy*, *Energy Policy* and *Energy Journal*. Apart from his academic background, Gert has wide experience with consulting various stakeholders in energy sectors in different countries.

Before joining Jacobs University, he was senior economist for the energy company EnBW AG (Germany) and held research positions in applied economics at Freiburg University (Germany), Tilburg University (Netherlands) and the University of Cambridge (UK).
